

CROCHET CUP COZY – PATTERN

(DESIGNED TO FIT A 20 OZ / 591 ML “VENTI” CUP)

MATERIALS

YARN: worsted weight (#4 medium) 100% cotton yarn, 23 g (35 m / 39 yds).

Substitutes: Any yarn of similar weight and fiber content can be used as a substitute.

HOOK: US G-6 (4.0 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge.

NOTIONS: yarn needle, scissors, tape measure.

GAUGE

8 sts and 8 rows = 2 in [5 cm] over textured stitch pattern using suggested hook.

Note: gauge is always taken after blocking.

SIZE

Finished width: 3.25 in [8.5 cm].

Finished length: 10.25 in [26 cm].

Fits standard 20 oz [591 ml] “Venti” cup.

PATTERN KEY AND STITCHES

PATTERN KEY: **ch** – chain

sc – single crochet

st or **sts** – stitch or stitches

yo – yarn over

rep – repeat

cm – centimeters

yd – yards

g – grams

RS – right side

WS – wrong side

STITCHES: **ch** – *chain*: yo and draw the yarn through to form a new loop without tightening the previous one.

sc – *single crochet*: insert the hook into a stitch, yo and draw up a loop, yo again and draw through both loops on the hook.

SPECIAL STITCHES:

FPdc – – *front post double crochet*: yo, insert your hook from front to back to front around the post of the stitch 2 row below and pull up a loop; yo and draw through 2 loops, yo and draw through the remaining 2 loops on the hook. Always skip the stitch behind each FPdc. [Tutorial here.](https://ohhahkovacrocheting.blog/)

Ret1-FPdc – *return 1 stitch back front post double crochet*: return 1 stitch back in the working row; yo, insert your hook from front to back to front around the post of the stitch 2 row below and pull up a loop; yo and draw

through 2 loops, yo and draw through the remaining 2 loops on the hook.

Always skip the stitch behind each Ret1-FPdc. [Tutorial here.](#)

Sk1-FPdc – *skip 1 stitch front post double crochet*: skip 1 stitch in the working row; yo, insert your hook from front to back to front around the post of the stitch 2 row below and pull up a loop; yo and draw through 2 loops, yo and draw through the remaining 2 loops on the hook in front of the skipped stitch. Always skip the stitch behind every Sk1-FPdc. [Tutorial here.](#)

Ret2-FPtr – *return 2 stitches back front post treble*: return back to the 2nd stitch in the working row; yo twice, insert your hook from front to back to front around the post of the stitch 2 rows below and pull up a loop; [yo and draw through 2 loops] twice, yo and draw through the remaining 2 loops on the hook. and work FPtr around the post of the stitch two rows below. Always skip the stitch behind every Ret2-FPtr. [Tutorial here.](#)

Sk2-FPtr – *skip 2 stitches front post treble*: skip the next 2 stitches in the working row; yo twice, insert your hook from front to back to front around the post of the stitch 2 rows below and pull up a loop; [yo and draw through 2 loops] twice, yo and draw through the remaining 2 loops on the hook in front of the 2 skipped stitches. Always skip the stitch behind every Sk2-FPtr. [Tutorial here.](#)

NOTES

The pattern is worked in rows. Beginning ch does not count as a stitch. Each Front Post stitch replaces the next stitch of the row, always skip the stitch behind any FPdc, or FPtr. FPdc and FPtr stitches are always worked around

the post of the stitch two rows below, whether that stitch is a regular sc, or a FPdc, or FPtr.

INSTRUCTIONS

Row 1: Ch 14, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

(Note: beginning ch 1 does not count as a st.)

Row 2 (WS) and every alternate row: Sc in each st across; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

Row 3 (RS): Sc in next 4 sts, Sk1-FPdc, sc in next 3 sts, Sk2-FPtr, sc in last 4 sts; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

Row 5: Sc in next 2 sts, Sk2-FPtr (around Sk1-FPdc), sc in next 4 sts, Sk1-FPdc (around Sk2-FPtr), sc in last 5 sts; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

Row 7: Sc in next 7 sts, FPdc (around Sk1-FPdc), sc in last 5 sts; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

Row 9: Sc in next 4 sts, Ret2-FPtr (around sc), sc in next 3 sts, Ret1-FPdc (around FPdc), sc in last 4 sts; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

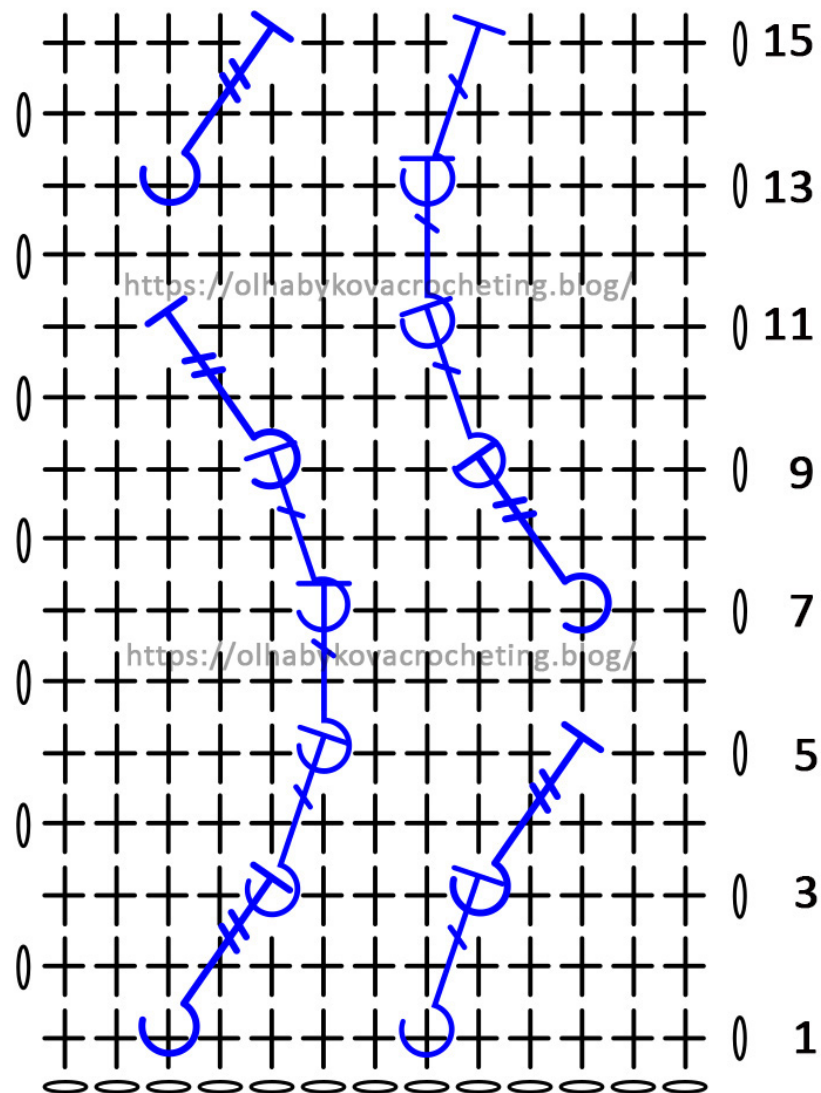
Row 11: Sc in next 5 sts, Ret1-FPdc (around Ret2-FPtr), sc in next 4 sts, Ret2-FPtr (around Ret1-FPdc), sc in last 2 sts; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

Row 13: Sc in next 5 sts, FPdc (around Ret1-FPdc), sc in last 7 sts; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

Row 15: Sc in next 4 sts, Sk1-FPdc (around FPdc), sc in next 3 sts, Sk2-FPtr (around sc), sc in last 4 sts; ch 1, turn – 13 sts.

Rep Rows 4-15 until the length of the cozy before seaming reaches 10.25 in [26 cm].

The number of rows may vary depending on your tension, adjust as needed.

The diagram shows the stitch repeat for Rows 4–15. Read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right. Refer to Key for stitch symbols.

Ret1-FPtr = shown in chart as a standard FPdc returning back over 1 stitch around the post two rows below.

Sk1-FPdc = shown in chart as a standard FPdc worked across 1 skipped stitches around the post two rows below.

Sk2-FPtr = shown in chart as a standard FPtr worked across 2 skipped stitches around the post two rows below.

Ret2-FPtr = shown in chart as a standard FPtr returning back over 2 stitches around the post two rows below.

Fasten off, leaving a 10 in tail for seaming.

FINISHING: With yarn needle, seam short ends together using mattress stitch. Fasten off and weave in ends.



Care for the finished piece according to the yarn label instructions.

Enjoy your creation! Whether you wear it, gift it, display it, or sell the finished product. Let it bring joy and comfort.
